Search

You can edit default settings for the primary backup location and add a secondary backup location. For information about TestNav, response file backups, and backup locations, refer to [Set up and Use TestNav](#).

When specifying the SFTP path, the port number is optional. The default port number is 22.

▼ You can define an absolute or relative path for SFTP locations:

- A relative path points to the local directory, and the URL contains a single forward slash or no slash.
- An absolute path is the defined complete path, and the URL contains two forward slashes.






Pearson recommends the following format for the SFTP backup location (port is optional):
sftp://<userid>:<password>@<address>:<port>/path.

1. From **Setup**, select **TestNav Configurations**. 
2. Type the configuration name into the search field, and click **Search**. 
3. Click the checkbox next to the configuration you want to edit. 
4. Click **Select Tasks**, select **Create / Edit TestNav Configurations**, and click **Start**. 
5. Type or select the cache configuration details or update an existing configuration.
