
When specifying the SFTP path, the port number is optional. The default port number is 22.

- · A relative path points to the local directory, and the URL contains a single forward slash or no slash.
- An absolute path is the defined complete path, and the URL contains two forward slashes.


Pearson recommends the following format for the SFTP backup location (port is optional): sftp://cuserid>:<password>@<address>:<port>/path.

Step-by-Step


1. From Setup, select TestNav Configurations.




2. Type the configuration name into the search field, and click Search.




3. Click the checkbox next to the configuration you want to edit.
