What is happening?

As Google continues its plan to phase out Chrome Apps, Pearson can assure customers **no impact** to testing with the TestNav app for Chrome OS (Chromebooks) **throughout the 2021-2022 calendar school year**.

[Google announced](#) continued support for Chrome Apps on Chrome OS *through June 2022*, and Pearson will mirror that support.

The TestNav development team is working toward providing customers and students a testing solution to replace the app before that date.

What does this mean?

Customers using the Chrome TestNav app can continue to do so throughout the 2021-22 school year.

Pearson continues to work with Google to reestablish support for [the Android TestNav app](#), which can run on Chromebooks.

The TestNav team also continues development efforts toward TestNav app improvements in advance of Google discontinuing Chrome App support.
